Tentative title (hereinafter, “the Manuscript”):

The California Dental Association (“CDA”) requires all authors of material contributed to the Journal of the California Dental Association (“The Journal”) to transfer copyright ownership of all contributed text and to grant certain licenses relating to clinical images, to CDA, the owner and publisher of The Journal. If the contributed material is jointly authored, all authors are co-owners of the copyright, and each author must execute a counterpart of this Article Submission Agreement.

Manuscript Text. The Manuscript includes textual and tabular material (“Manuscript Text”) and may also include illustrative graphics, photographs and reproductions of clinical images produced by x-ray, tomography, ultrasound or other mechanisms (“Clinical Images”).

Transfer of Copyright. In consideration of the CDA’s reviewing, editing and accepting the material for publication and other good and valuable consideration, the undersigned author(s) (hereinafter, jointly and singly the “Author”) hereby assigns to the Publisher, during the full term of copyright and any extensions or renewals of that term, all copyrights in and to the Manuscript Text, including but not limited to the right to publish, republish, transmit, sell, distribute and otherwise use the Manuscript Text and the material contained therein in electronic and print editions of The Journal and in derivative works throughout the world, in all languages and in all media of expression now known or later developed, and to license or permit others to do so. Author further grants to CDA, a non-exclusive, world-wide, paid-up and irrevocable license during the same term, to reproduce the Clinical Images in connection with any reproduction of the Manuscript Text or substantial portion thereof, in any and all media of expression now known or later developed, and to license or permit others to do so. Author understands and agrees that CDA may publish and distribute the Manuscript (including both Manuscript Text and Clinical Images) under its own name and any other imprints or trade names, and that CDA may copyright it in CDA’s name or any other name.

The Author warrants to CDA as follows: (a) the Manuscript is original (except for material in the public domain or as to which permission has been obtained from the copyright owner), (b) neither the Manuscript nor one with substantially similar content under the Author’s authorship has been published or is being considered for publication elsewhere, except as described in an attachment to this Agreement, (c) that the Author has identified in writing to CDA any material obtained from any source other than Author and has obtained all permissions required for the inclusion and reproduction of



such material, and (d) the Manuscript does not contain any libelous or otherwise unlawful material or infringe any copyright or otherwise infringe any personal or proprietary right of any person or entity. The Author understands and agrees that the Publisher and its designated editorial employees and contractors will have the right to make changes in the Manuscript (including its title) for clarity, brevity and conformity to style. The Author understands and agrees that, in the event that any person other than Author claims authorship or copyright in the Manuscript or any portion thereof, whether before or after publication in any form or forms, CDA reserves the right, but not the obligation, (i) to use any and all reasonable methods to ascertain authorship, (ii) to make an independent determination of authorship, and (iii) in the event that it determines that there is a substantial issue as to identity of authors of the Manuscript, to take any and all measures it chooses, in its discretion, to respond thereto, including without limitation, determining not to publish the Manuscript or to publish it in substantially altered form, to withdraw the Manuscript from any electronic media that are made available online or otherwise distributed, and to issue such qualifications and/or retractions as it deems appropriate in its full discretion.

Author certifies that any affiliations with or involvement in any organization or entity with a direct financial interest in the subject matter or materials discussed in the Manuscript (*e.g.*, employment, consultancies, stock ownership, honoraria, expert testimony) are disclosed in an attachment to this Agreement and will notify CDA of any relevant affiliations entered into at any time before the publication of the Manuscript by CDA. Author has listed research or project support in an acknowledgment in the Manuscript. Author understands and agrees that the Manuscript will be subject to anonymous review and agrees to produce to CDA and any editors or reviewers on request any and all data on which the Manuscript is based.

The Author reserves the right to utilize at no cost the Manuscript for scholarly or educational purposes, provided that: (i) such usage is solely for noncommercial purposes, (ii) proper acknowledgment is given to the source and (iii) the Publisher has been notified in writing of said intent. CDA will provide Principal Authors with 100 printed copies of the Manuscript as published at no charge and will sell additional reprints to Author at CDA's published rates, if the order is placed at least 15 days before publication.

If the Author has received funding from the National Institutes of Health ("NIH"), to comply with NIH policy, the Author must deposit with PubMed Central a digital copy of the Manuscript that has been accepted for publication by the Journal, but only so long as the Author directs NIH to delay publication in PubMed Central for 12 months following the official date of publication in the Journal.

In the event that the Publisher decides not to publish the Manuscript, the Author will be notified that it has not been accepted for publication, the copyright transfer and license granted to CDA under this Agreement shall be null and void, and all rights hereunder will revert to the Author and/or Author's licensors.
