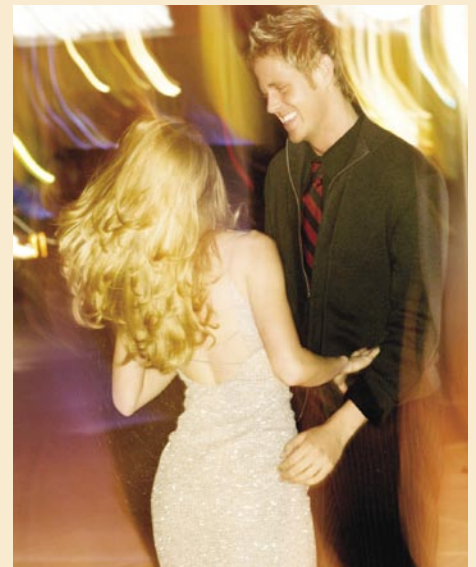

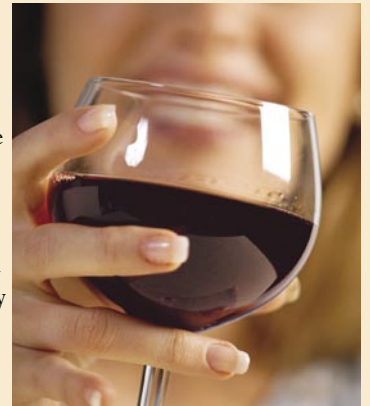

# DENTAL BOARD REQUIRED COURSES

## California Dental Practice Act and Infection Control — Ticketed Admission Only

The Dental Board of California requires mandatory education in infection control and California Dental Practice Act (formerly known as California Law). Every renewal cycle, California law requires licensed dentists and allied dental health professionals to complete 2 units in infection control and 2 units in the California Dental Practice Act in Category I. The California Dental Association is proud to present the following courses that will fulfill these required units for license renewal.

### Please note:

- Admission to these C.E. courses will be by ticket only.
- You may purchase your tickets in advance by registering online at [cda.org](http://cda.org). Tickets are \$10 and will guarantee your seat in the course.
- If available, tickets will also be sold on-site at the ticket booth located in the registration area of the Anaheim Convention Center.
- There will be no late entries allowed. The California mandatory education requires 2 full hours for credit. It is strongly recommended that you arrive a minimum of 15 minutes in advance of the published starting time.
- Seating is limited. Tickets will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Licensees are only required to attend one class on the California Dental Practice Act and one class on Infection Control.
