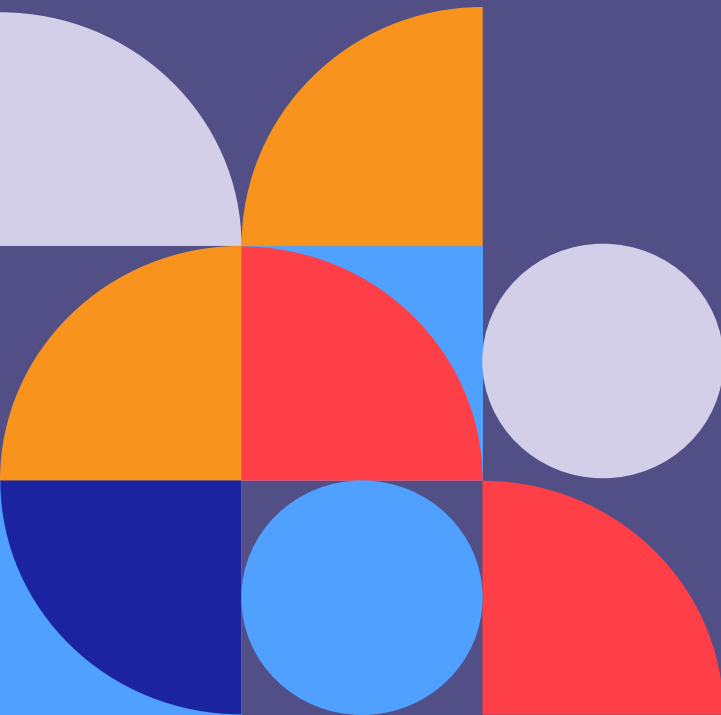

Welcome

The CDA Foundation is committed to the mission it launched in 2001:

“To improve the oral and overall health of all Californians by supporting the dental profession in its efforts to meet community needs.”

More than 22 years since the Foundation was established, we feel proud and privileged to still be representing the heart of dentistry and its philanthropic values. With the tireless work of our dedicated volunteers, the Foundation strives to improve access to long-term, essential, comprehensive oral health care in California for the thousands of individuals who face barriers to care.

Community wellness and service has long been a focus for the Foundation. Since the launch of CDA Cares in 2012, we have hosted 19 volunteer clinics, providing over \$25 million in no-cost dental services to more than 30,000 Californians. As the state continues to expand Medi-Cal Dental, our CDA Cares clinics are evolving to prioritize placing patients into dental homes, which will help elevate the oral health of California’s most vulnerable populations. We are eager to continue providing dental care to people in need.

Together, we are creating smiles and changing lives.

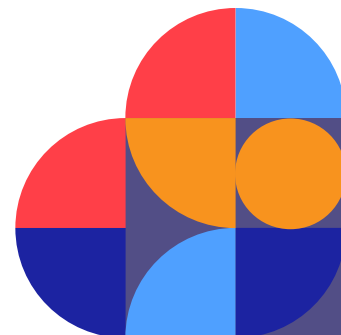

The Foundation has also partnered with the California Office of Oral Health and the state’s seven dental schools to administer grant funding to expand dental students’ opportunities to work in Medi-Cal Dental offices and to treat patients in historically underserved areas. Our hope is that this partnership, complemented by our ongoing involvement in CalHealthCares’ student loan and practice support grant programs, will empower these students to return to a dental desert community to practice dentistry after graduation, further expanding access to care in California. CDA also continues to advocate for CalHealthCares grant programs, which are funded through Proposition 56 tobacco tax revenue.

Additionally, the Foundation’s Wellness Program continues to bring awareness, support and assistance to dental professionals who are battling physical and/or mental ailments such as anxiety, depression and substance use disorders. The program advocates for the overall well-being of dental community members and their families, providing confidential peer-to-peer support and hands-on assistance throughout treatment and recovery.

Only through the generosity of volunteers, sponsors and donors like you can we continue to reach underserved Californians through these programs in new, innovative ways.

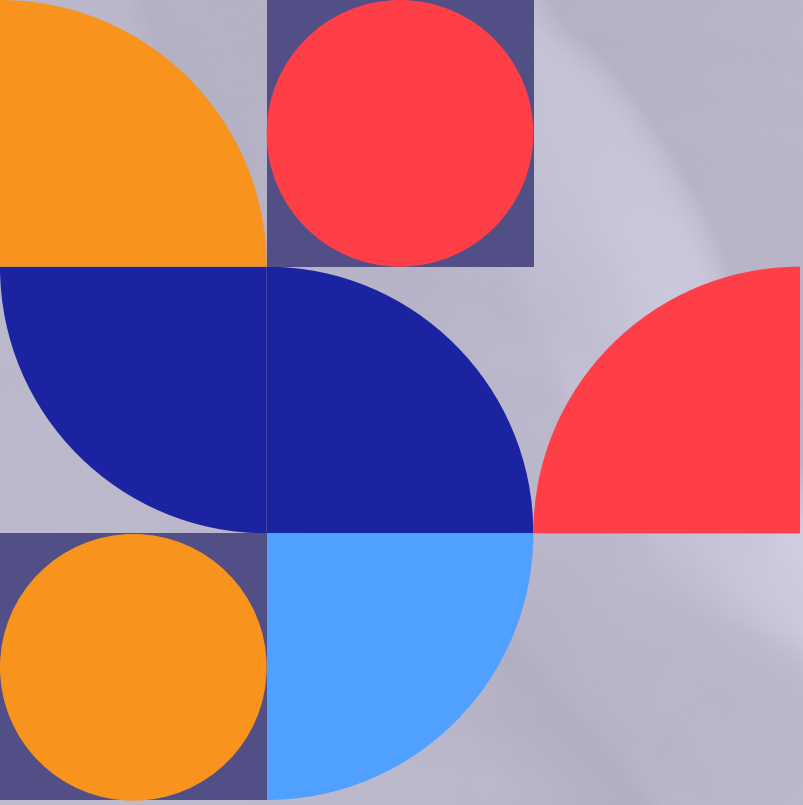

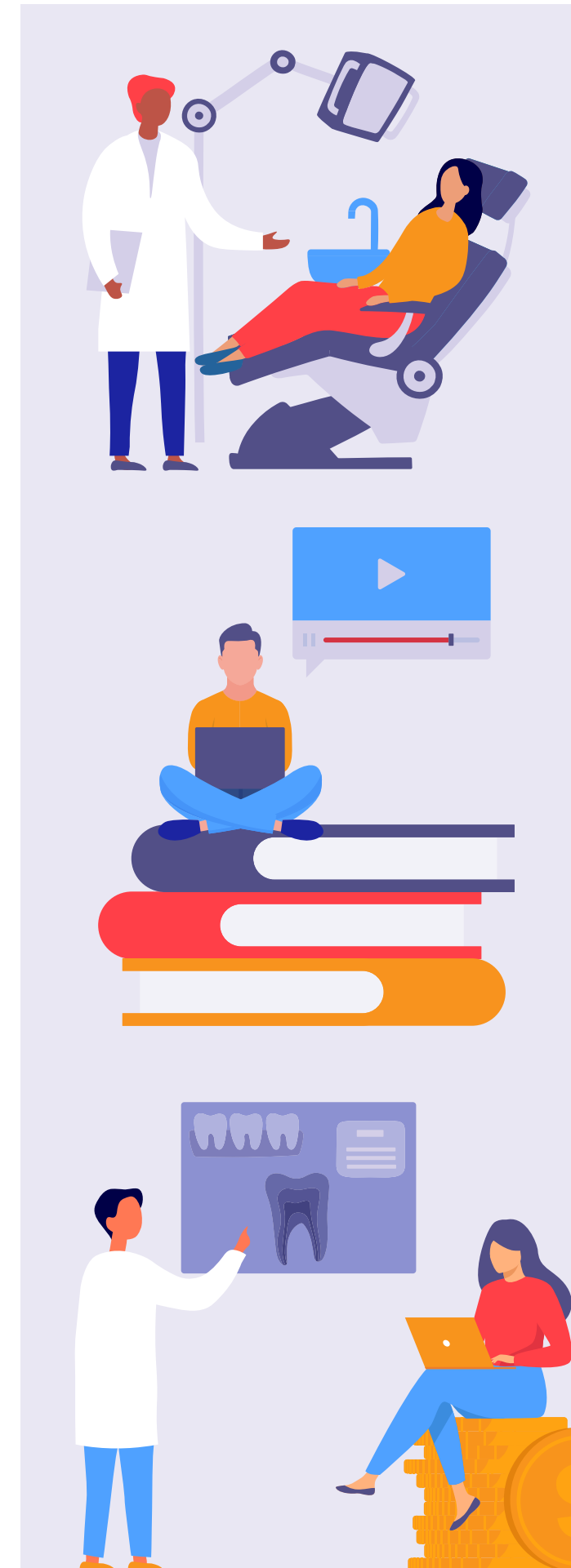

Ongoing Programs & Initiatives



Dental School Community-Based Clinical Education Rotations

Beginning in 2022 and continuing in 2023, the Foundation was selected as the grant administrator of [Community-Based Clinical Education funds](#), which CDA successfully advocated for in 2022. Dental schools in California are eligible to each receive up to \$1 million to expand their CBCE rotation sites in underserved communities throughout the state. In 2023, the Foundation began leading an advisory committee to review and approve grant applications. Our grant administration work will continue through 2027.

Specialty Dental Clinic Expansions

In 2023, the Foundation entered into a grant agreement with the California Health Facilities Financing Authority (CHFFA) to develop program guidelines, application processes, eligibility criteria and methodology for distributing grant funds for the [Specialty Dental Clinic Grant Program](#). The program is funded by a one-time investment of \$50 million from the state of California to help alleviate long wait times for people with special needs who are in dire need of timely, compassionate dental care. Grantees will receive funding to help build new or expand existing specialty dental clinics to serve individuals with physical, developmental or cognitive disabilities.



CDA Cares

Our volunteer-run CDA Cares events provide no-cost dental care in communities across California. To help create healthy new smiles throughout the state, we focus on connecting individuals without an established dental home with a dentist who can provide ongoing care.

Altogether, **30,314** people have received no-cost dental services at CDA Cares since the first event in 2012, reflecting **\$25.22** million in donated care

Wellness Program

The Foundation's Wellness Program supports and advocates for the mental, emotional and physical well-being of dental professionals and their families. The program is led by compassionate volunteer members and recovering dentists who provide confidential peer-to-peer support to CDA members

with **182,235** procedures completed through the work of more than **26,928** volunteers.

The Foundation is preparing to host more dental clinics in 2024, upholding the Foundation's mission to improve the oral and overall health of all Californians by supporting the dental profession in meeting community needs.

Health Equity

The CDA Foundation is committed to investing in a variety of health equity resources. In the past year, we have helped to curate several live, recorded and on-demand educational experiences focusing on

Vaccine Confidence

In 2022, the Foundation entered into a grant agreement with the California Department of Public Health to provide training and educational materials to dentists and the public on the administration and efficacy of COVID-19 vaccines. Specifically, the Foundation worked with the Arthur A. Dugoni School of Dentistry to create a continuing education course focused on COVID-19 vaccine administration, patient preparation and proper documentation. Over 130 dentists attended in-person courses hosted

at various locations throughout the state and over 300 dentists participated in the online course. A live version of this course was also offered at CDA Presents in Anaheim in 2023. Additionally, the grant facilitated the production of the Foundation's Vaccine Confidence Toolkit, which educates dentists, patients and the public on vaccine safety and efficacy. We are also pleased to share the Impact Report and Overview of the 2021–2023 Vaccine Confidence Grant.



Dental Team Workforce Initiatives

Smile Crew California

The Foundation, in partnership with CDA, helped launch a pilot dental assistant training program, Smile Crew California, which teaches participants the basic skills for a dental assisting career and provides the certifications required for dental assisting. The trainings include an online self-led learning module plus in-person classroom lessons with material developed by CDA staff in collaboration with member-dentists.

Smile Crew CA continues to be successful, placing most participants in open dental positions in California, creating job opportunities for workers displaced by the pandemic and helping member-dentists fill open positions in their practices. Since the initial pilot launched in 2020, the Foundation and CDA have partnered on 14 bootcamps, enrolling 212 participants in total and graduating 183. To date, bootcamps were hosted in San Bernardino, the South Bay of Los Angeles County, San Diego and San Francisco.

Additionally, the Foundation, in partnership with CDA, was awarded a two-year, \$5 million High Road Training Partnership in May 2023. Of the \$5 million, \$3 million will be administered through our programs and approximately \$2 million will pass through Jewish Vocational Services (JVS) as a subgrantee.

This grant will allow CDA and the Foundation to continue the Smile Crew CA campaign and expand the training programs to other locations across California. The funds will also be used to support component dental societies in hosting regional dental assistant training events (including training for dental assistants to become registered dental assistants); to help their members recruit bootcamp dental assistant participants; to assist placement of bootcamp graduates in CDA member offices; and to expand CDA educational offerings for members and their staff.

Foothill College Dental Assisting Apprenticeship Program

In 2021, the Foundation announced the launch of Foothill College's dental assisting apprenticeship program—the first of its kind in California. The 15-month program satisfies the number of work hours required by the Dental Board of California for the registered dental assistant licensure pathway.

The second cohort of the program graduated six new RDAs in December 2023. The students received certificates for infection control, the Dental Practice Act, coronal polishing, pit and fissure sealants and radiation health and safety. All graduates of the second cohort are currently working as dental assistants and have submitted their applications to the dental board.

The Foundation is proud to support this pathway to the dental community.



Fluoridation

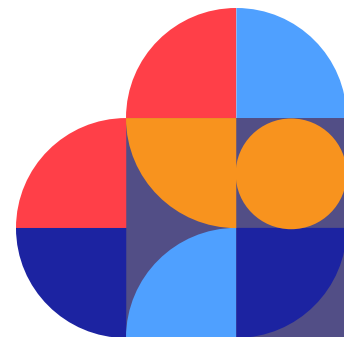
The California Oral Health Plan is focused on addressing determinants of health, healthy habits and population-based prevention interventions, which includes increasing the proportion of the California population served by community water systems with optimally fluoridated water. Some of the \$30 million allocated annually to the state oral health program has been set aside for local projects, and community water fluoridation is identified as a qualifying project.

CDA and the Foundation continue to monitor and contribute to these efforts to maintain and increase water fluoridation in California communities, including through educational meetings with policymakers and regular coordination with the California Oral Health Technical Assistance Center, a UCSF-based program supported by the California Department of Public Health's Office of Oral Health. In recent years, member-dentists have been successful in halting or reversing localized efforts to end community water fluoridation.

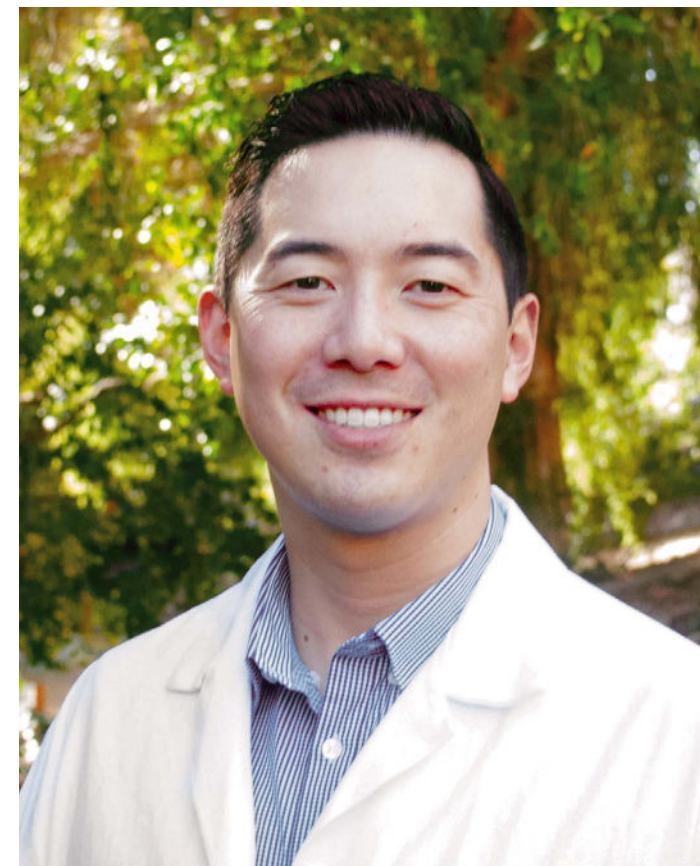
Caries Risk Assessment

The Foundation's online program increases dentists' confidence to see babies and young children, using caries risk assessment and chronic disease management principles to reduce the prevalence of dental caries. Known as TYKE (Treating Young Kids Every Day), the program is available online at cda.org and has been completed by more than 9,786 dental professionals to date. Providers enrolled in Medi-Cal Dental can access the course for free.

The Foundation has been at the forefront of supporting research on CAMBRA®, caries management by risk assessment, the results of which were published in 2003, 2007 and 2019 in the *Journal of the California Dental Association*.



Grants & Awards



Dr. Arthur A. Dugoni Faculty Award

The Dr. Arthur A. Dugoni Faculty Award acknowledges and supports eligible faculty affiliated with the state's six dental schools for their exceptional leadership, innovation, collaboration, compassion, philanthropic spirit and integrity in dental education.

Marc Hayashi, DMD, MBA, FACD, FICD, is the 2023 recipient of the Dugoni Faculty Award. He currently serves as the vice chair of the section of restorative dentistry at the UCLA School of Dentistry and holds the Alumni and Friends Presidential Endowed Chair. Dr. Hayashi is an innovative educator and leader at UCLA and in his professional societies. He was voted Teacher of the Year by UCLA students the past five years.

Dental Materials & Supplies Grant

The Foundation offers the Dental Materials and Supplies Grant to California's community-based organizations that provide dental care to underserved communities. The grant helps to minimize these organizations' operating expenses through the support of in-kind materials and supplies necessary for dental operations and oral health services.

Webb Family Grant

The Webb Family Grant historically provided an annual award of up to \$5,000 toward education expenses for the runner-up of the Foundation's Student Loan Repayment Grant. This year, the grant was reformatted as a stand-alone award with expanded eligibility. Now, students or recent graduates of a board-approved dental assisting or dental hygiene program and educational programs approved by the Dental Board of California or the Dental Hygiene Board of California are eligible for the award. As in prior years, a deserving recipient may receive up to \$5,000 for educational or program expenses.

In 2023, the Webb Family Grant awarded \$5,000 to **Maria Augello, RDH**, a recent graduate of the Shasta College Dental Hygiene Program.

"The awarded grant money will significantly lessen my financial burden of student loan debt and allow me to reach the long-awaited financial stability and security I have worked so hard to obtain sooner than I anticipated when I began my dental hygiene career goal. In return, I can continue to reach my next goal, obtaining my bachelor's degree in dental hygiene as I seek to advance my career with confidence, determination and ongoing education to better serve my patients."

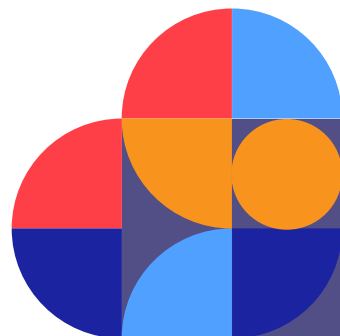
