Welcome

The CDA Foundation is committed to the mission it launched in 2001: to improve the oral and overall health of all Californians by supporting the dental profession in its efforts to meet community needs.

More than 23 years after our founding, we're proud and privileged to represent the heart of dentistry and its philanthropic values. Through equally tireless and fulfilling work, we empower thousands of individuals who face barriers to care. One important way we do this is by increasing individuals' access to long-term, essential, comprehensive oral health care.

Community wellness and service has long been a focus for the Foundation. Since 2012, we've hosted 19 CDA Cares events that provided over \$25 million in no-cost dental services to more than 30,000 Californians. Like many of you, we are eager to continue providing care to people in need. As the state continues to expand the Medi-Cal Dental program, our CDA Cares clinics are evolving to prioritize placement of patients into dental homes, which will help more Californians receive ongoing and comprehensive dental care.

The Foundation has also partnered with the Office of Oral Health and California's seven dental schools to administer grant funding that expands opportunities for dental students to treat patients in historically underserved areas throughout the state. The Community-Based Clinical Education grant's overarching goal is to increase dental students' exposure in Medi-Cal Dental office environments and to provide care to underserved communities.

Together, we are creating smiles and changing lives.



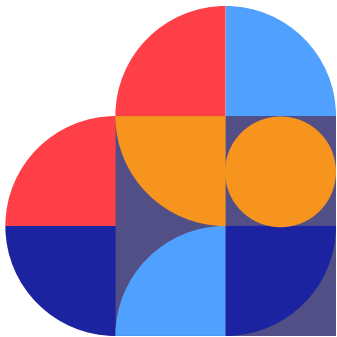

This work is complemented by CDA's legislative advocacy for continued funding for the CalHealthCares student loan repayments and practice support grants. Funded through Proposition 56 tobacco tax revenue and Proposition 34 MCO tax revenue, the CalHealthCares program empowers students who completed the rotation sites to return to the same site or serve in similar dental desert communities once they are licensed.

Additionally, the Foundation's Wellness Program continues to bring awareness and support to dental professionals who are battling physical and/or mental ailments, including anxiety, depression and substance use disorders. The program advocates for the overall well-being of dental community members and their families with confidential peer-to-peer support and hands-on assistance throughout their treatment and recovery.

The program continues to grow after CDA successfully advocated last fall for specified course offerings on provider wellness and burnout to count for continuing education units for license renewal. CDA will sponsor some of these C.E. courses at its annual convention, CDA Presents The Art and Science of Dentistry, and via live and on-demand webinars.

Only through the generosity of volunteers, sponsors and donors like you can we reach underserved Californians in new, innovative ways. We look forward to delivering more smiles across our great state in the years to come.

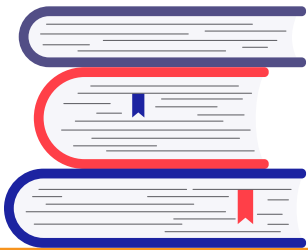

See how the Foundation utilized donations in 2024.

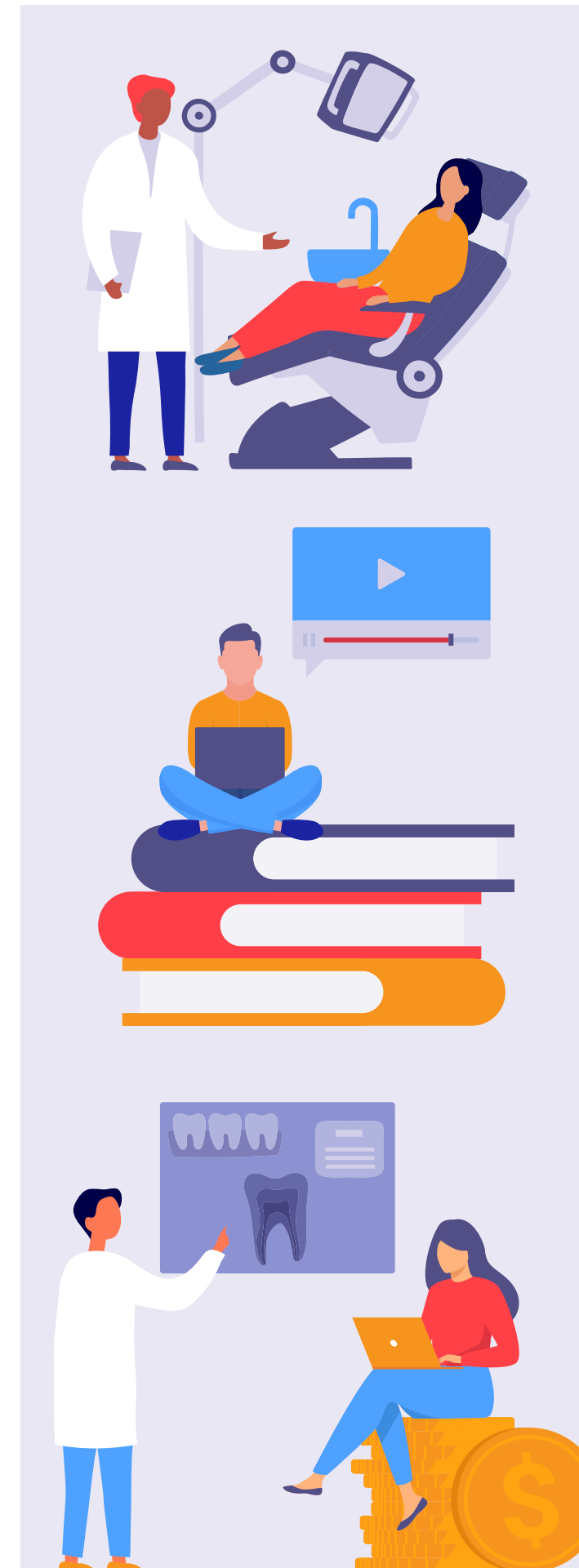

Ongoing Programs & Initiatives



Health Equity

Over the years, the CDA Foundation has helped to curate live, live-recorded, online and e-learning educational experiences covering an array of health equity themes in dentistry. Recordings of many webinars and e-learning opportunities are available through CDA's [Online Learning platform](#). Our webinar in 2024 focused on trauma-informed patient care with an emphasis on diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging.

Specialty Dental Clinic Expansions

Beginning in 2023 and continuing in 2024, the CDA Foundation entered into a grant agreement with the California Health Facilities Financing Authority to develop program guidelines, application processes, eligibility criteria and methodology for distribution of grant funds for the [Specialty Dental Clinic Grant Program](#). The funding for the program comes from a one-time investment of \$50 million from the state of California to help alleviate long wait times for people with special needs who are in dire need of timely and compassionate dental care. Grantees will receive funding to help build new or expand existing specialty dental clinics that will serve individuals with physical, developmental or cognitive disabilities.

Dental School Community-Based Clinical Education Rotations

Beginning in 2022 and continuing through 2024, the CDA Foundation was selected as the grant administrator of the Community-Based Clinical Education funds that CDA successfully advocated for in 2022. Each dental school in California will be eligible to receive funds to expand their CBCE rotation sites in underserved communities throughout the state. In 2024, the Foundation began approving applications and disbursing funds to California Northstate University College of Dental Medicine, University of the Pacific Arthur A. Dugoni School of Dentistry, and Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC. Work on this grant will continue through 2027.



CDA Cares

Our volunteer-run CDA Cares events provide no-cost dental care in communities across California. In August 2024, we hosted a small CDA Cares clinic at the Children’s Dental Health Clinic in Long Beach. Our new clinic model allowed us to treat and place community members without access to reliable dental care into long term dental homes for comprehensive care.

Additionally, in October 2024, the CDA Foundation partnered with the California Department of Public Health Office of Oral Health, California Department of Health Care Services, Trinity County Public Health

Department and Smile Dental Services to host a four-day dental clinic in rural Weaverville in Northern California.

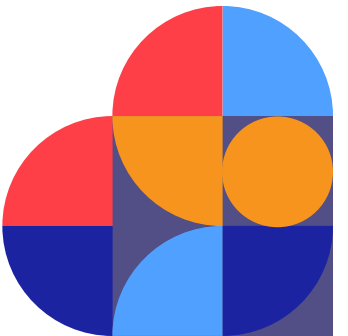
Altogether, **30,470** people have received no-cost dental services at CDA Cares since the first event in 2012, reflecting **\$25.25 million** in donated care with **182,619** procedures completed through the work of more than **26,977** volunteers.

The Foundation received generous support from corporate sponsors, which helped ensure the success of CDA Cares Long Beach.

Wellness Program

The Foundation’s Wellness Program supports and advocates for the mental, emotional and physical wellness of dental professionals and their families. The program is led by compassionate volunteer members and recovering dentists who provide confidential peer-to-peer support to CDA members

experiencing substance use disorders, anxiety, depression and burnout. In addition to offering biennial wellness training to member volunteers in leadership, the Foundation in 2024 continued to partner with [CDA to curate online and in-person wellness-focused lectures and panel-style events.](#)





Dental Team Workforce Initiatives

Smile Crew California

The CDA Foundation, in partnership with CDA, helped to launch pilot dental assisting training programs, called [Smile Crew CA](#), which continue to be successful — placing most of their participants in open dental positions in California, creating job opportunities for workers who were displaced by the pandemic and helping member-dentists fill open positions in their practice.

These trainings teach participants dental terminology, HIPAA compliance, infection control protocols and other basic skills needed for a dental assisting career. Importantly, the trainings let participants obtain the certifications required for dental assisting and include an online self-led learning module plus in-person classroom lessons with material developed by CDA staff in collaboration with member-dentists.

Since the initial pilot, the Foundation and CDA have partnered on 16 bootcamps with 233 participants

enrolled and 203 participants completing their training. To date, the training programs have been hosted in San Fernando Valley, San Bernardino, South Bay of Los Angeles County, San Diego and San Francisco.

In 2023 the CDA Foundation, in partnership with CDA, was awarded a two-year, \$5 million grant through California's High Road Training Partnership program. \$3 million will be administered through the Smile Crew CA program and approximately \$2 million will be passed through to Jewish Vocational Services as a subgrantee.

The grant has allowed CDA and the Foundation to continue the Smile Crew dental assisting training bootcamps and bring them to more locations in the state this year. The grant will also fund local dental societies' regional dental assistant trainings, support the placement of trained participants in dental offices and expand educational offerings for CDA members and their staff.

Fluoridation

The California Oral Health Plan addresses determinants of health, healthy habits and population-based prevention interventions, which include increasing the proportion of the California population served by community water systems with optimally fluoridated water. The State Oral Health Plan receives allocated funds from Proposition 56 annually, and those funds have been set aside for local projects. Community water fluoridation is identified as a qualifying project. For example, funding is provided for statewide technical assistance to local health jurisdictions, public water systems and other individuals or organizations to support their fluoridation efforts.

CDA and the Foundation continue to monitor and contribute to these efforts to maintain and increase water fluoridation in California communities, including through educational meetings with policymakers and regular coordination with the California Oral Health Technical Assistance Center, a UCSF-based program supported by the Department of Public Health's Office of Oral Health. In recent years, there has been an uptick in local efforts to eliminate fluoride, creating opportunities for the CDA Foundation and other partners to educate the profession and public about the importance of community water fluoridation programs.

Caries Risk Assessment

The CDA Foundation's online program TYKE (Treating Young Kids Every Day) increases dentists' confidence to see babies and young children using caries risk assessment and chronic disease management principles to reduce the prevalence of dental caries. TYKE [is available at cda.org](#) and has been completed by more than 10,596 dental professionals to date. The course continues to be made available for free to providers enrolled in Medi-Cal Dental.

The Foundation has been at the forefront of supporting research on caries management by risk assessment (CAMBRA®), the results of which were published in 2003, 2007 and 2019 in the Journal of the California Dental Association.





Grants & Awards

Dr. Arthur A. Dugoni Faculty Award

The Dr. Arthur A. Dugoni Faculty Award acknowledges and supports eligible faculty affiliated with California's seven dental schools for their exceptional leadership, innovation, collaboration, compassion, philanthropic spirit and integrity in dental education.

The 2024 recipient, **Natasha Lee, DDS**, currently serves as an assistant professor and course director of practice management and jurisprudence at University of the Pacific Dugoni School of Dentistry. Dr. Lee's leadership, service and motivating teaching methods demonstrate her commitment to student success.



Webb Family Grant

The Webb Family Grant supports the education and/or training of dental professionals in California, dental related educational programs in California and educational efforts that expand access to oral health care for underserved communities, organizations and individuals. Deserving recipients may receive up to \$5,000 for educational or program expenses.

The 2024 Webb Family Grant awarded \$5,000 to **Sylvia Akar, DMD, MPH**, a recent graduate of the Arizona School of Dentistry and Oral Health. Akar currently works at Clinicas del Camino Real in Ventura County. She plans to continue working in Federally Qualified Health Centers and aspires to become a dental director at an FQHC, which will enable her to influence policy and program development to better serve marginalized communities.

Dental Materials & Supplies Grant

The CDA Foundation offers the Dental Materials and Supplies Grant to California's community-based organizations that provide dental care to underserved communities. The grant helps to minimize these organizations' operating expenses through the support of in-kind materials and supplies necessary for dental operations and oral health services.
