Welcome

The CDA Foundation is committed to the mission it launched in 2001: to improve the oral and overall health of all Californians by supporting the dental profession in its efforts to meet community needs.

More than 24 years after our founding, we're proud and privileged to represent the heart of dentistry and its philanthropic values. This commitment is reflected in the Foundation's continued focus on advancing health equity through education, research and practical support for the dental profession. In 2025, this work included adding free live and on-demand webinars that equip dental teams with evidence-based tools to better serve Californians. Topics such as effective fluoride communication, culturally responsive care and minimally invasive dentistry support clinical decision making, strengthen patient trust and improve outcomes in communities that have historically faced barriers to care.

The Foundation continues to partner with the Office of Oral Health and California's seven dental schools to administer grant funding that expands opportunities for dental students to treat patients in underserved areas throughout the state. The Community Based Clinical Education grant's overarching goal is to increase dental students' exposure in Medi-Cal Dental office environments and to provide care to underserved communities.

In January 2025, the Foundation swiftly activated its Disaster Relief Program to raise more than \$300,000 in direct assistance for members of the dental community whose lives and livelihoods were disrupted by the devastating Southern California wildfires. These funds supported 48 dentists and 42 dental team members by addressing their immediate and emergency needs during a critical period of recovery.

Additionally, the Foundation's Wellness Program continues to bring awareness and support to dental professionals who are battling physical and/or mental ailments, including anxiety, depression and substance use disorders. The program advocates for the overall well-being of dental community members and their families with confidential peer-to-peer support and hands-on assistance throughout their treatment and recovery.

Only through the generosity of volunteers, sponsors and donors like you can we reach underserved Californians in new, innovative ways. We look forward to delivering more smiles across our great state in the years to come.

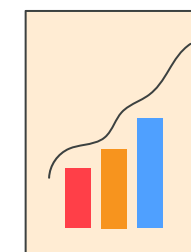
Health Equity

Over the years, the CDA Foundation has developed and co-curated live, live-recorded, online and e-learning educational experiences covering an array of health equity themes in dentistry. Recordings of many webinars and e-learning opportunities are available through CDA's [Online Learning platform](#). Our webinars in 2025 focused on health equity for all California communities, including fluoride education and safety, minimally invasive dentistry and provider wellness.



Oral Health Equity Report

The Foundation and CDA jointly released the [Oral Health Equity Report](#) in September 2025 to advance equitable access to dental care across the state. The report offers a data-driven framework that highlights persistent disparities in oral health and recommends strategies to strengthen patient care, support recruitment and retention of a diverse dental workforce, and guide public and private investment in equity-focused solutions. Building on decades of CDA leadership in access and inclusion, the report is intended to inform policy, practice and resource allocation in ways that improve outcomes for underserved communities and reinforce the profession's commitment to equitable care for all Californians.



Specialty Dental Clinic Expansions

Beginning in 2023 and continuing through 2025, the CDA Foundation entered into a grant agreement with the California Health Facilities Financing Authority to develop program guidelines, application processes, eligibility criteria and methodology for distribution of grant funds for the [Specialty Dental Clinic Grant Program](#). The funding for the program comes from a one-time investment of \$50 million from the state of California to help alleviate long wait times for people with special needs who are in dire need of timely and compassionate dental care.

In March 2025, 13 grantees were awarded funding to help build new or expand existing specialty dental clinics that will serve individuals with physical, developmental or cognitive disabilities. The grant recipients will use the state budget funds CDA successfully advocated for to develop or expand roughly 124 dental operatories, surgery suites and other facilities to serve patients with special health care needs.



Dental School Community-Based Clinical Education Rotations

Beginning in 2022 and continuing through 2025, the CDA Foundation was selected as the grant administrator of the Community-Based Clinical Education funds that CDA successfully advocated for in 2022. Each dental school in California is eligible to receive funds to expand their CBCE rotation sites in underserved communities. In 2025, the Foundation approved [new rotation sites for all seven California dental schools](#) totaling 25 locations across the state. Work on this grant will continue through 2027.

Wellness Program

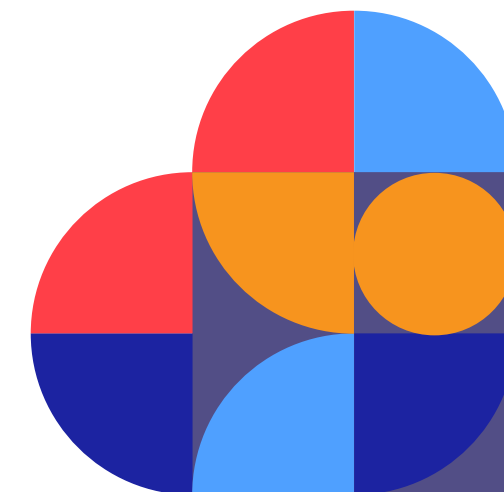
The Foundation's Wellness Program supports and advocates for the mental, emotional and physical wellness of dental professionals and their families. The program is led by compassionate volunteer members and recovering dentists who provide confidential peer-to-peer support to CDA members experiencing substance use disorders, anxiety, depression and burnout. In addition to offering [biennial wellness training to member volunteers in leadership](#), the Foundation in 2025 continued to partner with CDA to curate online and in-person wellness-focused lectures and panel-style events.

CDA Cares Connects

Our volunteer-run CDA Cares events provide no-cost dental care in communities across California. Since 2024, we have shifted our focus to connecting individuals without an established dental home with a dentist who can provide ongoing care. With this new goal in mind, these efforts have been [rebranded as CDA Cares Connects clinics](#) to highlight the warm handoff we provide patients for ongoing dental care beyond the day of the clinic event.

Altogether, **30,470** people have received no-cost dental services at CDA Cares since the first event in 2012, reflecting **\$25.25** million in donated care with **182,619** procedures completed through the work of more than **26,977** volunteers.

The Foundation is preparing to host dental clinics in 2026 and beyond, upholding its mission: to improve the oral and overall health of all Californians by supporting the dental profession in its efforts to meet community needs.



Fluoridation

The California Oral Health Plan addresses determinants of health, healthy habits and population-based prevention interventions, which include increasing the proportion of the California population served by community water systems with optimally fluoridated water.

CDA and the Foundation continue to monitor and contribute to efforts to maintain and increase water fluoridation in California communities, including through educational meetings with policymakers and regular coordination with the California Oral Health Technical Assistance Center, a UCSF-based program supported by the Department of Public Health's Office of Oral Health.

The CDA Foundation and its partners are responding to local efforts to eliminate fluoride by educating the profession and public about the importance of community water fluoridation programs. Water fluoridation resources published in 2025 include:

- [Water Fluoridation: It's beneficial, safe and saves money](#) — a one pager to support fluoride advocates in showing the investment value of community water fluoridation
- [Fluoride Varnish and Community Water Fluoridation](#) — a one pager that explores the dual benefit of topical and ingested fluoride sources for disease prevention
- [Water Fluoridation: The Science of Concentration](#) — a guide reviewing the dose-dependence of fluoride for neurodevelopment and gut microbiome safety

Studies with methodological flaws are being used to cast doubt on fluoride's benefits and raise unfounded concerns about its safety. In "[Fluoride Facts, Myths & Meaningful Conversations](#)," the first part of a webinar series developed by CDA in partnership with the Foundation, experts in dental public health, pediatric dentistry and medicine address this misinformation. The second webinar, "[Tooth Truth: Advocacy Skills for Fluoride Champions](#)," presents strategies for navigating a fluoridation challenge at the community

level and offers the best evidence and talking points for media outreach. These skills have become increasingly important to communicate the safety and efficacy of water fluoridation on a broader scale.

Caries Risk Assessment

The CDA Foundation's online program TYKE (Treating Young Kids Every Day) increases dentists' confidence to see babies and young children using caries risk assessment and chronic disease management principles to reduce the prevalence of dental caries. More than 11,476 dental professionals have completed TYKE to date. The course [is available on CDA's website](#) and remains free to providers enrolled in Medi-Cal Dental.

The Foundation has been at the forefront of supporting research on caries management by risk assessment (CAMBRA®), the results of which were published in 2003, 2007 and 2019 in the Journal of the California Dental Association.



Dental Team Workforce Initiatives

Smile Crew California

The CDA Foundation, in partnership with CDA, helped to launch pilot dental assisting training programs, called Smile Crew CA, which continue to be successful — placing most of their participants in open dental positions in California, creating job opportunities for workers who were displaced by the pandemic and helping member-dentists fill positions in their practice.

These trainings teach participants dental terminology, HIPAA compliance, infection control protocols and other basic skills needed for a dental assisting career. Importantly, the trainings let participants obtain the certifications required for dental assisting and include an online self-led learning module plus in-person

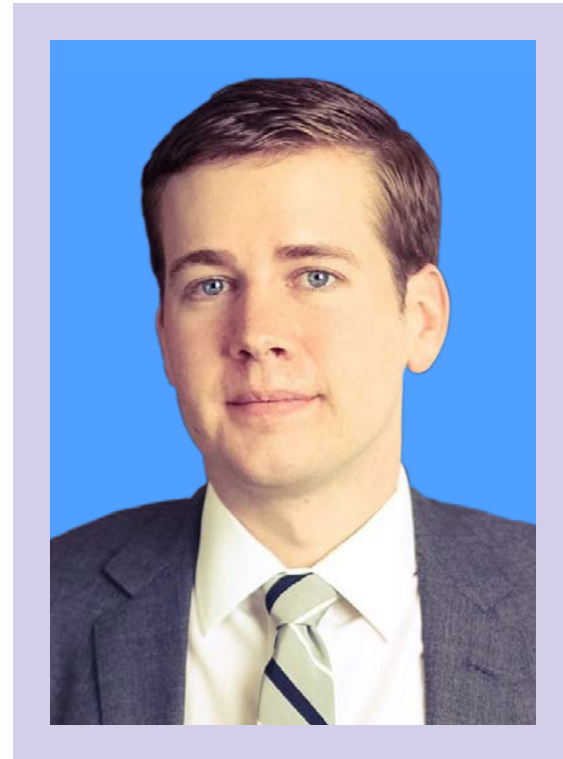
classroom lessons with material developed by CDA staff in collaboration with member-dentists.

Since the initial pilot, the Foundation and CDA have partnered on 20 bootcamps with 309 participants enrolled and 271 participants completing their training. To date, the training programs have been hosted in San Fernando Valley, San Bernardino, South Bay of Los Angeles County, San Diego and San Francisco.

In 2023 the CDA Foundation, in partnership with CDA, was awarded a two-year, \$5 million grant through California's High Road Training Partnership program. \$3 million will be administered through the Smile Crew CA program and approximately \$2 million will be passed through to Jewish Vocational Services as a subgrantee. In 2025, an 18-month extension was approved to allow the grant term to run through June of 2027.

The grant has allowed CDA and the Foundation to continue the Smile Crew dental assisting training bootcamps and bring them to more locations in the state this year. The grant will also fund local dental societies' regional dental assistant trainings, support the placement of trained participants in dental offices and expand educational offerings for CDA members and their staff.

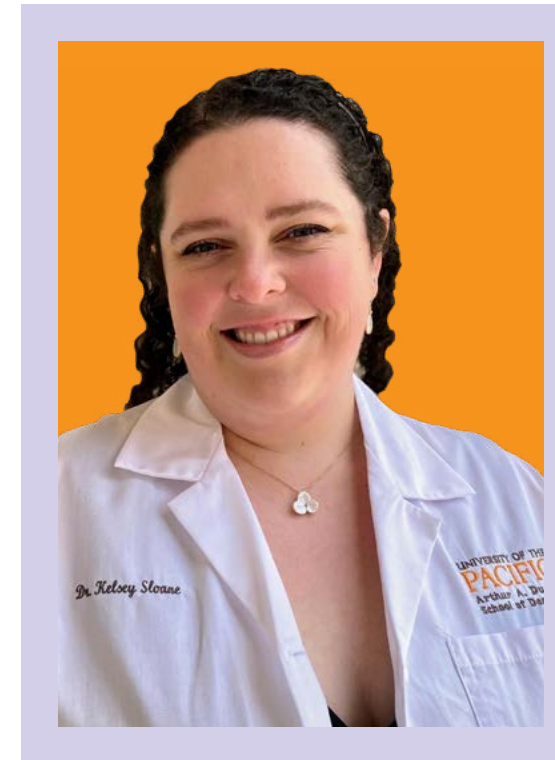

His leadership, service and motivating teaching methods demonstrate his commitment to student success.

The Webb Family Grant supports the education and/or training of dental professionals in California plus dental-related educational programs in California and educational efforts that expand access to oral health care for underserved communities, organizations and individuals. Deserving recipients may receive up to \$5,000 for educational or program expenses.

Dr. Sloane currently works at United Health Indian Services serving American Indian and Alaska Native communities of Humboldt and Del Norte counties.

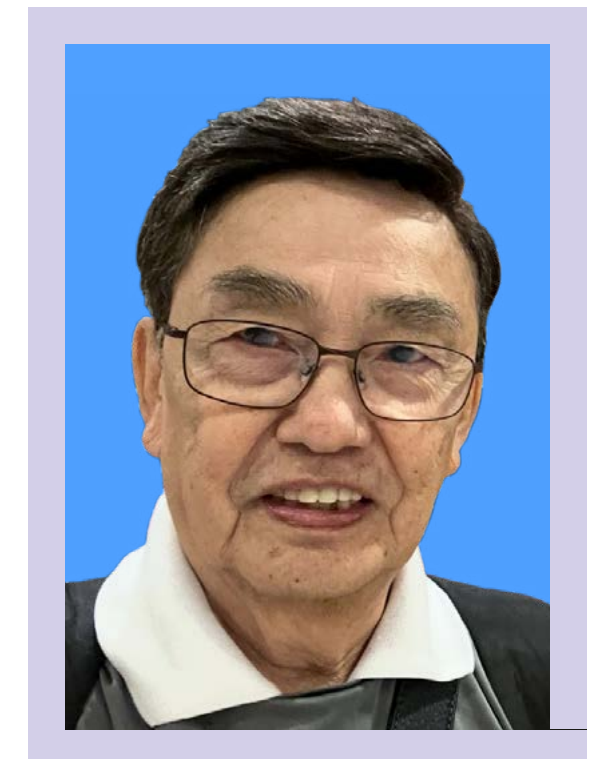


Humanitarian Award →

Edgardo de la Vega, DDS, [received the Foundation's 2025 Humanitarian Award](#), which recognizes California dentists who have distinguished themselves through a lifetime of outstanding, unselfish leadership and contributions to fellow human beings in the field of dentistry.

Dr. de la Vega has embodied unselfish volunteerism and leadership throughout his career, balancing his dental practice in San Fernando Valley with his missions abroad for more than 50 years. Since 1975, he has coordinated quarterly missions to the Philippines to provide treatment for residents facing barriers to care. To support this work, he founded Dentistry for Every Village in 2015, a nonprofit dedicated to improving access to dental care for rural villages in the Philippines.

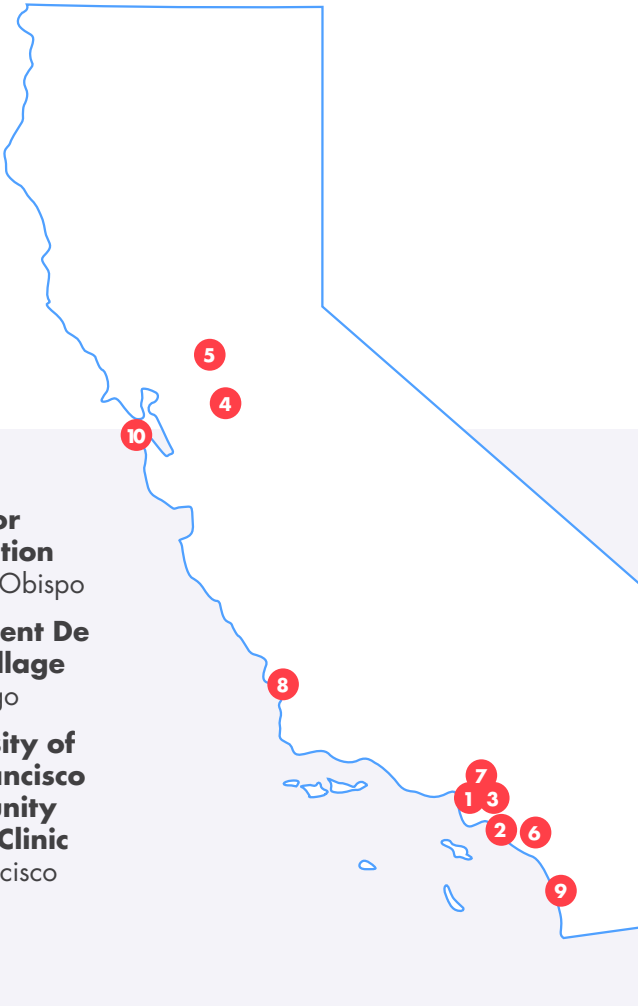
Disaster Relief Grant

The Foundation in January 2025 assembled its disaster relief committee to provide emergency assistance to colleagues who were impacted by the Eaton and Palisades fires that destroyed parts of Los Angeles County. The [committee awarded emergency funds](#) totaling \$300,000 to 90 dental professionals. The disbursement nearly equaled the total amount raised, which included contributions from individuals, companies and numerous state dental associations. The Foundation remains committed to helping dental professionals affected by natural disasters and seeks support for this fund when and if it is needed.

Dental Materials and Supplies Grant

The CDA Foundation offers the [Dental Materials and Supplies Grant](#) to organizations in California that provide dental care to underserved communities. The grant helps to minimize the organizations' operating expenses through the support of in-kind materials and supplies necessary for dental operations and oral health services. 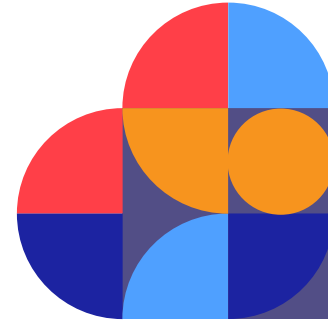

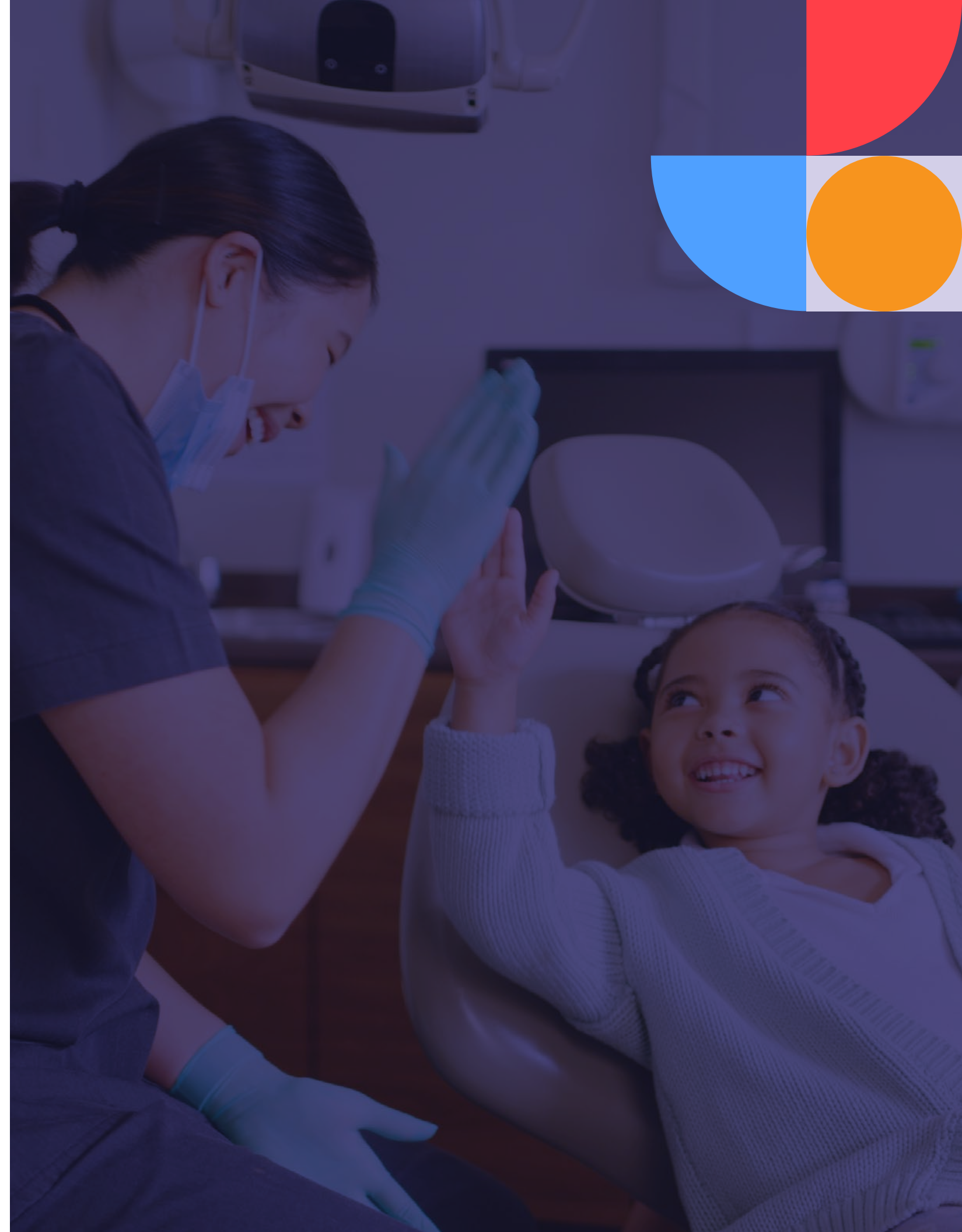
